

BOILER UPGRADE SCHEME FROM 1ST APRIL 2022

Operated by Ofgem, this scheme is designed to help offset the higher cost of purchasing a heat pump by offering an upfront payment voucher to the installer, on behalf of the property owner.

KEY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

INSTALLER: Must be MCS Accredited & a member of the RECC

APPLICANT: Owner Occupier / Private Landlord

TECHNOLOGIES: Air Source Heat Pumps, Ground Source Heat Pumps (including water source heat pumps), where replacing fossil fuelled or electric heating system (not including heat pumps). Biomass boilers where replacing fossil fuelled system (not including mains gas) or electric heating system (not including heat pumps).

CAPACITY LIMIT: 45 kW total capacity limit, including for shared ground loop systems.

TYPE OF BUILDING: Domestic and non-domestic buildings are eligible. Social housing and new builds are not eligible. Custom builds are eligible as long as evidence is provided confirming they are custom builds.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS: Must meet full space heating and hot water requirements.

HEAT PUMPS: Minimum seasonal coefficient of performance of 2.8.

ENERGY PERFORMANCE CERTIFICATE: No recommendations to install loft or cavity wall insulation unless exempt from doing so.
